Working Together - This involves maintaining a **Learning Climate** based on high expectations, trust, respect and mutual understanding, ensuring our vision and values permeate the life of our school.

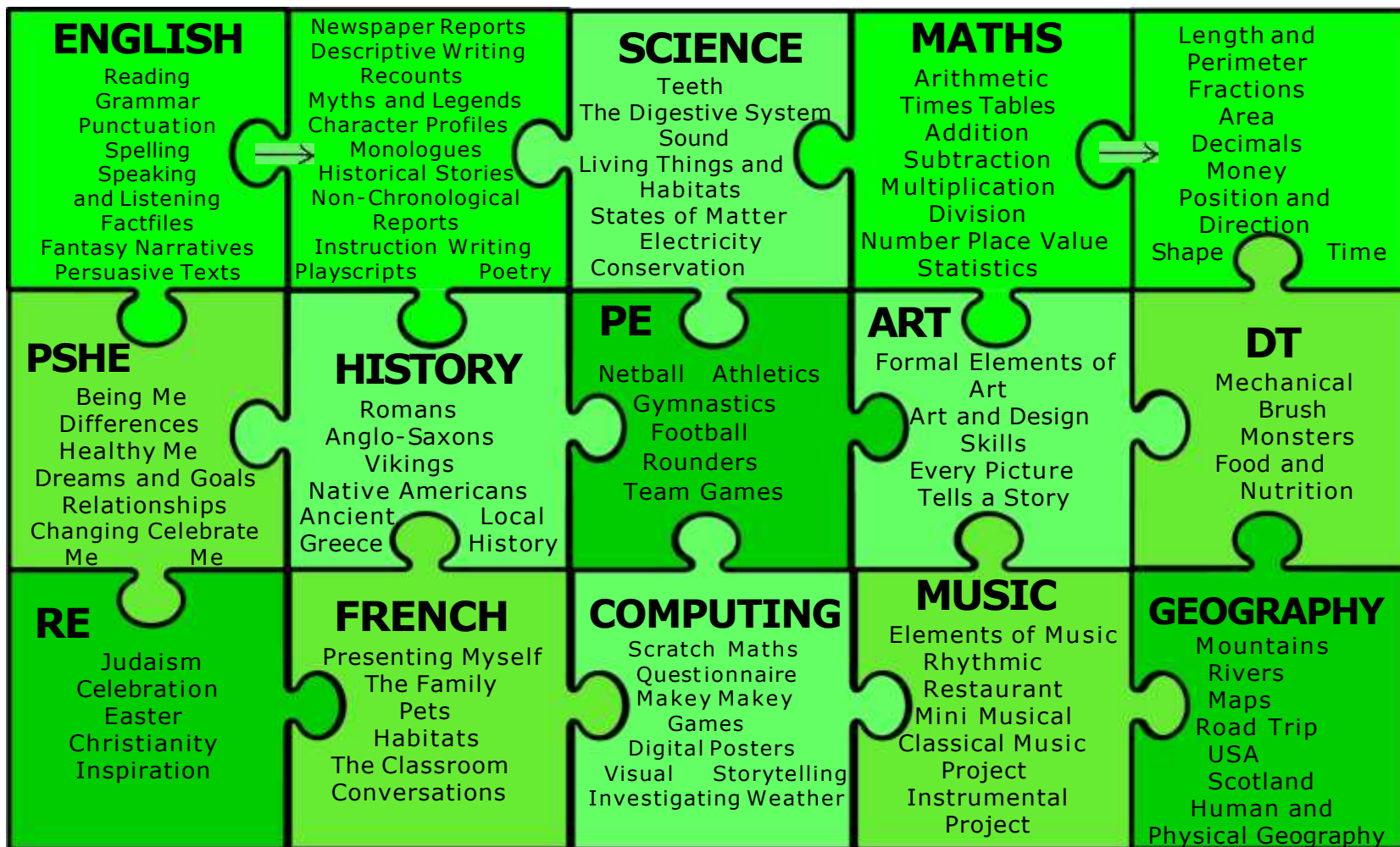
